Description of Parish/benefice

Crofton is a relatively affluent commuter suburb that is overwhelmingly residential. Orpington Station is 20 minutes by fast train to London Bridge and 25 minutes to Charing Cross. There is little by way of shopping, leisure, or employment



opportunities within the parish boundaries but these are close by in Locksbottom, Orpington and Bromley. Benefiting from highly regarded primary schools (3) and secondary schools (2), the parish is increasingly a magnet for families with children/youth replacing the elderly generation from the 1950s and 1960s.
